□ Set up the situation: setting, characters, background information, and conflict.

Establish point of view: who is telling the story? Why?

□ Write a smooth progression of events.

□ Dialogue

□ Pacing

C:

□ Use a variety of techniques to sequence events: varied transition words, flashback, description, foreshadowing, and dialogue.

D:

□ Use precise words and phrases which allow the readers to experience the situation, characters, and settings.

□ Write a conclusion which follows and reflects on the story. And/or provides a resolution to the conflict.
