I:

Use the **i**ntroduction and first paragraph to predict the main idea (or to create a big question you think the text will answer):

E:

Write down **e**verything you know about the topic. Use back of this paper, if necessary. Circle any of your notes you would like to know more about or write a question about it.

V:

List three important **v**isuals and predict how they will help you understand the text

E:

Guess the answers for the **e**nd-of-chapter questions, read any summaries—and write down **e**very bold or *italicized* word.

S:
