Language from Poem	What Type? (See below)

- Metaphor:** Two things used to compare or contrast with "is" example: "Life is a dream"
- Simile:** Two things compared using like or as. Example "As blind as a bat"
- Personification:** Giving things human qualities: "Your computer hates me."
- Hyperbole:** Exaggeration used often with humor. "I could eat a horse."
- Alliteration:** Repeating the beginning sound in words for a phrase "Bobby blew big, blue bubbles"
- Imagery:** A word or phrase you can visualize while reading "the blue dome of the sky above"
- Symbol:** A word or object that stands for something else. "the dove of peace"
