Two things used to compare or contrast with "is" example: "Life is a dream" Metaphor:

Simile: Two things compared using like or as. Example "As blind as a bat"

Personification: Giving things human qualities: "Your computer hates me." Hyperbole: Exaggeration used often with humor. "I could eat a horse."

Alliteration: Repeating the beginning sound in words for a phrase "Bobby blew big, blue bubbles" Imagery: A word or phrase you can visualize while reading "the blue dome of the sky above"

Symbol: A word or object that stands for something else. "the dove of peace"
