


Grade 4 Narrative Writing

Level 3 Rubric Requirements



- Paper develops real or imagined experiences or events using effective technique, descriptive details, and clear event sequence (W3)
- Establishes a situation and introduces a narrator and/or characters (W3a)
- □ Sequence of events unfolds naturally (W3a)
- Describes character, plot, problem, and solution with concrete sensory details (W3d)
- Uses **dialogue** and/or **description** to develop experiences and events or show the **responses of characters to situations** (W3b)
- Uses a variety of **transitional words** and phrases to manage the **sequence of events** (W3c)
- Uses **concrete words** and phrases, and **sensory details** to convey experiences and events (W3d)
- Provides a conclusion that follows from the narrated experiences or events (W3e)
- Develops and strengthens writing by planning, revising, and editing (W5)
- Editing demonstrates command of English language: corrects
 capitalization, spelling, and punctuation (W5)
- Uses time for **reflection**, and **revision** (W10)
- Accomplishes **keyboarding** of at least **one page** in a single sitting



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
