

Grade 5 Narrative WritingLevel 3 Rubric Requirements



Paper develops real or imagined experiences or events using effective technique, descriptive details, and clear event sequences (W3)
Establishes a situation and introduces a narrator and/or characters (W3a)
Sequence of events unfolds naturally (W3a)
Uses dialogue and/or description and pacing to develop experiences and events or show the responses of characters to situations (W3b)
Describes character, plot, problem and solution with concrete sensory details (W3d)
Uses a variety of transitional words , phrases and clauses to manage the sequence of events (W3c)
Uses concrete words and phrases and sensory details to convey experiences and events precisely (W3d)
Provides a conclusion that follows from the narrated experiences or events (W3e)
Takes notes on resources and sorts evidence into categories (W8)
Develops and strengthens writing by planning , revising , and editing (W5)
Editing demonstrates command of English language: corrects capitalization, spelling, and punctuation (W5)
Uses time for reflection , and revision (W10)
