1.	ENGAGE:
	Observe your critter. Ask your critter a testable question. Ask questions you could read about.
2.	EXPLORE:
	Investigate your question. Design an experiment, conduct a focused observation, take
	notes.

3.	EXPLAIN:
	Process the information/experience, propose an explanation, solidify what was learned in any format: chart, notes, diagram, etc.
4.	APPLY:
	List dangling questions, explore further; read for more information.
